





VIEW OF LIME LAKE LOOKING SOUTHWEST TOWARD MACHIAS

Lime Lake, popular fishing, swimming and boating resort, lies in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains, in the northeast corner of the Town of Machias, Cattaraugus County. It is 1200 feet above sea level and covers approximately 500 acres. The lake was named because of shell lime deposits on its bottom.

Fed entirely by springs, it is an artificial lake, originally consisting of three ponds. It was dammed up at the north end about 1839 to provide water power for a feed and saw mill and has two outlets, one at the north under the Old Mill Roller Rink and one at the south. Its waters eventually empty into the Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic Ocean since the northern outlet flows into Cattaraugus Creek on into Lake Erie and the southern outlet into Ischua Creek south to the Allegany River.

First settlement at Lime Lake was in 1813 and today several families and businesses make up Lime Lake hamlet, a year around residence. The first school house, a log structure, was built in 1819; the first saw mill in 1823 by Andrew McBizzell; the first grist mill in 1823 by David Potter. Howard Peck and Alva Jefferson operated the first store in the locality and the first inn was run by a Widow Freeman in 1820. The only woolen mills ever to exist in the Town of Machias were run by Follett and Colgrove at Lime Lake about 1835. These mills operated day and night with people coming from distant places and camping out and waiting to have their work done.

The lake's water power enabled a flour and grist mill, operated by Jacob Wurst and John E. Euchner, to flourish in 1874 and 1875. Years later the Queen City Milk Company used lake water power to operate a modern milk plant here. Its building has since been converted into a roller skating rink, now operating.

Lime Lake also served as a great source of ice before electric refrigeration and the manufacture of artificial ice. The first ice house was built about 1880 by Newton and Armstrong for the Webster Ice Company of Buffalo. It was destroyed by fire. A second ice house was built by W. L. Markham and a third by the Citizens Ice Company of Buffalo, on the site now occupied by the pavilion, at the park here about 1888. Three more ice houses were built by the Webster Ice Company in 1890, 1892 and 1896 so that the total capacity of the ice harvest per year was approximately 145,000 tons. These ice houses were later razed when the electric age came on.

The Odosagih Bible Conference Grounds on the southwest shore of Lime Lake were once Hazelmere Park. There the famous old Hazelmere Hotel stood on high ground until destroyed by fire. The park was not used for many years until a dance hall was constructed by Earl Pratt. The Odosagih Bible Conference Association purchased the dance hall and park and has since held meetings and conferences there. They continually improve and add to their grounds. Several cottages now line their shore.

Lime Lake is now one of New York State's popular recreation centers. The Lake and its outlets are stocked with fish each year by the New York State Conservation Department with the assistance of the Lime Lake Sportmens Club, the Franklinville Conservation Club and the Kiwanis Club of Delevan-Machias.

The Pennsylvania Railroad runs along the east shore of the lake and crosses the Baltimore and Ohio about a half mile south of the lake at Machias Junction.



The Town of Machias is located on elevated tableland between the waters of the Allegany River and Cattaraugus Creek. Its soil is a clay and gravel loam suitable for cereal and stock raising. Cheese making, once a major industry, died out several years ago and today the town is primarily a dairy farming community. Many of its farms produce pure maple syrup used throughout the nation

Population of Machias is 1,391 (1960 Census) and its principal industry is gravel and sand mixing. Two major companies, the Olean Gravel Co. and the Buffalo Slag Co., Inc., ship hundreds of tons of mixed gravel from huge pits in Machias.

The village was originally known as Machias Five Corners, or Chickasaw and was a stopping place for teamsters and travelers on the road between Olean and Buffalo. Major Timothy Butler was the first resident, coming here with his family from Machias, Maine in 1813. He built a distillery and manufactured rum from maple syrup. Increased settlement and the development of last block factories, cheese plants, ice houses and mills near Lime Lake made a flourishing community.

The old burial ground was located one mile north of Machias village and named Brewer Cemetery. About 50 years later the present Maple Grove Cemetery was established. It lies a half mile west of the village on School Street, shaded by trees. A still older cemetery than the Brewer Cemetery existed until a few years ago. It is in the Gulf District, so was known as Gulf Cemetery. The remains of old Revolutionary soldiers buried there were interred in the newer Maple Grove Cemetery in a Memorial Day ceremony in 1940.

Amerilla Brown was mistress of the first schoolhouse in Machias built in 1827 a mile north of the village. It burned down in 1830. About 1900 a new school was built on the present site of the newer part of the school now standing, but in 1913

this, too, burned down. The very next year it was rebuilt and stands today with an addition made in 1935. It is part of the Delevan-Machias Central School system which was formed in 1949. The building was used as one of five classroom sites until a new \$1,400,000 kindergarten through 12th grade building was opened. Ground was broken on June 18, 1957 in Delevan and the school was opened in September, 1958. It was dedicated May 24, 1959. The last class, using one room, was discontinued in the Machias building at the end of the 1958-59 school year.

In 1827, too, the first Post Office was established here with Joseph Kinne Jr. as postmaster. Today's postmaster is Frank G. Zarabski.

Machias was chosen for the site of the Cattaugus County Farms and Welfare Home for the Aged. Buildings were erected at the present location in 1835. The original wood building burned but the Napiers built the stone building in 1868. It still stands and can be seen from the lake. It was remodeled in 1961 to match the new infirmary adjoining it.

First religious sect founded in the town was the Free Will Baptist. Today there are five churches in the town—Machias Methodist, First Christian, Machias Wesleyan Methodist, St. Christopher and Holy Family Catholic. All hold services every Sunday.

The Methodist church was organized in 1822 with five members. Meetings were first held in the schoolhouse. In 1839 the Methodists, Christians and entire community jointly built the present First Christian Church (known as Congregational-Christian). The Methodists broke away and erected their own church in 1853.

The First Congregational-Christian Church was established in 1827 by Joseph Bartlett, and it also had five members to begin with.

Third church organized here was the Wesleyan Methodist in 1888 by the Rev. B. F. McLaughlin.

St. Christopher Catholic church was the fourth in the town, built by cottage owners in 1941 at the north end of the lake. First services started in July, 1941.

Holy Family Church was built under the direction of the Missionary Apostolate at the corner of Route 16 and Franklin Street, with construction starting in October 1951. First Mass was held June 22, 1952 when the church was dedicated. A new parish hall and rectory was built in 1954 and dedicated October 17, 1954.

George A. Stoneman was the first commander of the Phillips Post No. 329, G.A.R., founded in 1883 by Col. W. H. Hicks of Arcade. All those veterans are deceased.

Urania Lodge No. 810, F. & A.M., was established in 1894 with William A. Joslyn the first master. The building was erected in 1894 by D. S. Tilden, his son and Dr. Clarence King.

The Glenn A. Pratt Jr. American Legion Post No. 1460, Inc. has its own club, formerly the G.A.R. building. Wayne Rogers is the post commander.

The Pennsylvania Railroad enters Machias from Buffalo near the northeast corner and runs nearly straight south, crossing the Baltimore and Ohio at Machias Junction. The Junction was once the larger village and a post office was established, but on June 29, 1940 it was removed and now mail is delivered there by a route from Machias.

Another shipping point of some importance in Machias was called Summit Station in the southwestern part of the town on the Rochester branch of the old Buffalo, Rochester and Pittsburgh Railroad. It contained some stores, a school-house and about a dozen dwellings. Today only a few of the original buildings remain.

The entire township in 1817 had a population of 11 families.

Today the township is governed by a town board with the supervisor, Edward Fabian, presiding officer. The village is unincorporated, thus the township, here, which includes Lime Lake, has jurisdiction over the municipal affairs of the town, roads and lake.

The club has acquired 38 acres of land on the West Valley road, where trap shooting has been held Sunday mornings. There the club is raising 300 pheasants. Club members promote and help in the stocking of fish in local waters. Plans for club grounds includes a stocked pond, where a fishing rodeo will be held, activity for sportsmen and a future clubhouse. Membership is open to all interested persons. CATTARAUGUS COUNTY HOME & INFIRMARY

Machias is the home of the new Cattaraugus County Welfare Department's \$1,750,000 public infirmery, largest and most expensive construction project ever located in this township. Work started during the winter of 1959-60, 125 years after the establishment of the first County Poor Home at Machias. The new facilities were dedicated in public ceremonies in 1961.

In 1869 the Home cared for 225 persons. Today an average of 80 men and women are cared for. The Home provides facilities for domiciliary and infirmery care of the chronically ill, the aged, the infirm and those persons with failing mental faculties whose conditions do not warrant commitment to a mental hospital.

About 80 per cent of those under care here are infirm and convalescent. The aged and ambulatory chronically ill men were housed in the old stone building



at the north end of the grounds. Women were housed in a separate building and a small infirmary provided care for bed patients.

The new County Infirmary now joins the entirely re-modeled stone building and extends as one building south to the south building. It provides 100 beds in the infirmary with the most modern facilities for recreation and rehabilitation as well as medical and personal attention.

Changes in the grounds have been underway since 1948. Grounds provided large gardens for fruit and vegetables. Landscaping was carried out. In 1954 the women's cottage was demolished. Refrigeration and freezing facilities were completed in 1951.

The county farm, which was operated for almost 100 years, was ordered closed by the County Board of Supervisors in early 1957. Farm stock, equipment and tools were sold at public auction for approximately \$25,000 in April, 1957. A month later the farm was sold and has changed hands twice. Remaining county property for the farm was sold at public auction in 1958 and the last of the county-owned lots was sold to Carlton Wirges in 1959.

Modernization and expansion have been carried out each year. The new infirmary provides housing and care for many other welfare patients who formerly were served in private nursing and rest homes throughout the county,

Hazard E. Robinson, commissioner of public welfare for 20 years, will retire in December 1961. A successor will be elected by the voters of Cattaraugus County in November. C. Jack Blackhall of Machias is the deputy commissioner, an office created by the Board of Supervisors in 1960. He and his wife Bernice, supervise the county home and infirmary.

THE ODOSAGIH BIBLE CONFERENCE GROUNDS

A small group of ministers and laymen from seven different denominations in this region gathered in 1912 in what was known as Hazelmere Grove. This was the organization of the Odosagih Bible Conference. The first conferences were conducted only a few days each year until some years ago the time was increased to 15 days each session.

In 1927 the 23 acres at Lime Lake, including buildings, was purchased for \$13,000. This has been paid. About 10 acres of land and the Napier home were purchased in 1946. Thousands of dollars worth of equipment has been added during the years. The work has reached out in Youth Conference, Girls' Camp and Boys' Camp. This is not only a Christian Center for Odosagih, but other groups, as the American Sunday School Union, Bible Clubs, Christian Home League and Christian Missionary Alliance make use of the grounds.

Five or six other conferences throughout New York and Pennsylvania are the outgrowth of Odosagih. Bible teachers have taught thousands of people from churches of Western New York, Pennsylvania and Ohio. This interdenominational work is carried on by free will offerings. Many missionaries now in foreign fields began at Odosagih.

Besides the meetings held in the tabernacle, some of the most important are the groups of 100 to 200 gathered in devotional services about campfires in the woods. The hills, lake and wooded grounds give an ideal setting for recreational and spiritual atmosphere. Nearly every year a large number are baptized in the lake.


