## What is the LLCOA and BOD?

The Lime Lake Cottage Owners Association was formed with the following objectives:

- To mutually benefit the members of the LLCOA and the protection of owner's property on or near the shores of Lime Lake

The Board of Directors of the LLCOA oversees many tasks and activities, including:

- Attending meetings on scheduled dates designated by the President
- Willing to take part in any present and future projects
- Any given assignments must be reported to the President, in a timely manner, so status can be communicated to the rest of the Board
- Purchasing of agents to control weed growth in the lake, scheduling application date designated by the DEC and notifying members of the scheduled date.
- Coordination of water quality testing and monitoring and management of fish population by the NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation (DEC)
- Control water levels through management of the spillway located at the north end of the lake
- General maintenance of the spillway shed
- Maintenance of the Broad Bay Circle buildings, playground and sports facilities for the use of all members
- Conducting numerous social events throughout the summer (see annual schedule of events)
- Coordinating with publisher any article and member photo submissions for annual Lime Lake Directory
- Publishing and mailing of LLCOA Newsletter in Spring
- Managing key-access to the LLCOA boat launch on Broad Bay Circle

# LLCOA CONTINUES TO PARTICIPATE IN NYSDEC'S CITIZENS STATEWIDE LAKE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM ("CSLAP") (\*\*1\*\*)

## 2023 CSLAP REPORTS:

Please refer to the LLCOA website under the Water Quality Tab for reports on the 2023 lake sampling. The 2023 CSLAP Field Data Report is posted.

(\*\*1\*\*) The CSLAP Program is a long-term water quality monitoring program that helps to identify water quality issues, detect seasonal and long-term patterns, and inform volunteers and lake residents about conditions in their lake. CSLAP volunteers collect water quality data following standard methods to evaluate nutrient enrichment, aquatic weed and algae growth, and the recreational quality of the lake. In addition to water quality sampling, CSLAP volunteers also collect information on:

- Lake perception
- Freshwater harmful algal blooms (HABs)
- Invasive species distribution
- Special studies

## Weed Treatment



The Bureau of Pest Management is responsible for the administration of the Aquatic Pesticide Permit Program in New York, under the authority granted by the Environmental Conservation Law (ECL) and Rules and Regulations of the State of New York.

The application of aquatic pesticides is regulated by the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) through pesticide registration, pesticide applicator certification, pesticide business registration and two types of aquatic pesticide permits. The combined use of these management tools provides oversight for the control of aquatic pests while preserving and protecting the waters of the State.

Every year an application must be completed and submitted to the DEC. The application for 2024 has been submitted to the DEC. Once approved, the lake will be surveyed by our applicator, Smith Creek Fish Farm, for “weed treatment necessity.” Treatment for this year is tentatively scheduled for June .

Signs will be posted around the lake prior to the weed treatment and an email will also be sent to LLCOA members.

Joe Tymorek from the LLCOA Board of Directors will be working with Todd Garrison from Smith Creek Fish Farm, LLC on the coordination of our 2024 weed treatment. Thank you, Joe and Todd!

Dear riparian owner/user,

To control the excessive growth of the invasive aquatic plant, Eurasian watermilfoil (*Myriophyllum spicatum*), in Lime Lake, The New York Department of Environmental Conservation is permitting the owners to treat with ProcellaCOR® EC. A copy of the product label is available for review by following the website links below, or by calling Joe Tymorek at 716.541.4078 to request a paper copy.

Treatment using ProcellaCOR® EC is anticipated to occur the week of June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Treatment will proceed only after the L.L.C.O.A has obtained approved permits for the treatment from the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC). This pesticide application will only occur if sufficient aquatic vegetation is present to warrant treatment and under favorable weather conditions.

As an affected riparian owner/user, you have the right to consent or object to the restrictions of water use resulting from this proposed treatment. The water use restrictions associated with use of the proposed pesticide is:

- **Do not use water treated with ProcellaCOR® EC for agricultural crops, greenhouse, nursery, and hydroponic irrigation or livestock watering for 24 hours. Treated water must be analyzed and determined to be less than 1 ppb active ingredient or determined by Department approved model to have degraded/diluted to below 1 ppb unless an activated carbon or similar filtration process is utilized prior to the water use.**

You have twenty-one (21) days to respond to this notice. If you wish to object to the proposed treatment and the water use restrictions resulting from the treatment, please file a written document stating your objection.

## LLCOA's Broad Bay Circle Property

### GUIDELINES



Only LLCOA members and their guests are allowed to use this property. Below are some reminders about storage and parking. If you rent your property out, please make sure your renters are aware of these rules.

**STORAGE.** This facility may not be used for the storage of items such as boats, boat trailers, campers, large trailers, construction equipment, construction dumpsters, etc. without written consent of the Board. Requests should be submitted to the Board via email: [LLCOA.ORG@GMAIL.COM](mailto:LLCOA.ORG@GMAIL.COM). An Extended Period Parking Request form will need to be completed. The form is available on the LLCOA website. If the extended parking request is approved a Permit will be issued. It must be placed on the parked vehicle during the extended stay. Violators will be advised in writing to remove the storage item within seven days. If a violation continues, the Board will contact appropriate authorities for the storage item to be ticketed and/or towed away. Personal items such as picnic tables are not allowed to be placed on the property.

**PARKING.** This facility may only be used by Members and individuals visiting the Member's property for parking of properly registered and licensed vehicles. Parking is limited to the shoulder area of the property. The Board reserves the right to contact appropriate authorities for any unauthorized vehicle to be ticketed and/or towed away. Members are responsible for repairing any damage to this property resulting from their parked motor vehicles, e.g. ruts.

In addition, golf carts and other type vehicles are not allowed to be ridden on the lawn area of BBC. The only exception would be when there is an LLCOA event and volunteers are using their golf cart or other vehicle to bring or remove supplies, etc.



## LLCOA Lake Guidelines for Rentees/Tenants



- The general direction of all boat traffic is in a **COUNTERCLOCKWISE** direction around the lake.
- Please drive all watercraft vehicles responsibly.
- Please keep to the left of all buoy markers on the lake. These identify stumps or shallow water. (Please refer to the map in the Lime Lake Directory for these areas.)
- All boats and boat operators must abide by New York State Boating Laws.
- Under a new New York State law, known as Brianna's Law, all motor boat operators:
  - \* Born after Jan. 1, 1993 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2020.
  - \* Born after Jan. 1, 1988 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2022.
  - \* Born after Jan. 1, 1983 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2023.
  - \* Born after Jan. 1, 1978 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2024.

All motor boat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2025.

- United States Coast Guard approved life jackets are required to be worn for personal watercraft use, as well as when being towed by a boat (skiing, tubing, wakeboarding, etc.).
- Waterskiing, and similar towed activities, are limited to the hours between sunrise and sunset. There must be a person, other than the operator, of at least ten years of age, in a position to be a "spotter" who can look out for accidents or see if the person being towed has fallen.
- Stay a minimum of 75' away from shore, docks, and other boats at all times when powered above idle speed.
- Please abide by the marked **NO WAKE ZONES - 5 MPH** through the channel and Little Bay.
- No littering or tossing objects into the lake.
- A New York State fishing license is required for anyone over the age of 16.
- Please keep music to an acceptable volume both on the property and on the lake.
- Please be courteous with noise after 11:00 PM.
- Any Rentee/Tenant who does not comply with these lake guidelines will be reported to the Renter for further action. We have established these guidelines to protect both parties of the renter-tenant relationship, along with the safety and consideration of all our LLCOA property owners.

Thank you for helping us keep our lake a wonderful and enjoyable place for everyone.

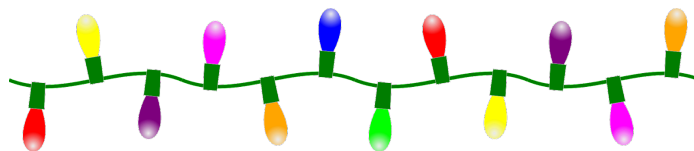

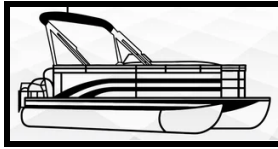
Later that evening we had 10 Delaware perform for us. Their music and energy were fantastic!

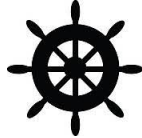

# Safe Boating



New York State provides boating safety certificates to those people who successfully complete a New York State Safe Boating Classroom Course. New York State also recognizes the safety certificates issued by the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary, the US Power Squadron and the US Powerboating. Boating Safety Certificates from several online course providers are approved for New York State residents

## Who needs a boating safety certificate?

### Motorboats

Under a new law, known as Brianna's Law, all motor boat (including power boat, PWC's, Jetski) operators:

- Born on or after Jan. 1, 1993 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2020. (*in effect this summer*)
- Born on or after Jan. 1, 1988 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2022.
- Born on or after Jan. 1, 1983 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2023.
- Born on or after Jan. 1, 1978 will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2024.
- All motor boat operators regardless of age will need a boating safety certificate beginning in 2025.

The LLCOA will not be providing an on-site, in-classroom Safe Boating course this year.

The LLCOA recommends, should you require a safe boating course certificate, to please access the online classes approved by New York State.

### Online Class Instruction

The Boating Safety Certificate course requirements can also be completed online through one of the courses listed below.

- Courses are available at your convenience; just click one of the links below to begin your online learning experience. Course providers are responsible for any fees they may charge.
- Learning is completed online, successful completion of unit exams is required in order to advance through the course and ultimately undertake a comprehensive final exam.

### Personal Watercraft

Anyone operating a Personal Watercraft (JetSki™, Wave Runner™, etc.) must have a boating safety certificate, and be at least 14 years of age or older.

Boating Safety certificates issued in other states: If you are a New York resident, you will need to have a NYS boating safety certificate; if you are from out-of-state, New York recognizes the boating safety certificate issued by your home state, however you must have your certificate with you.

Operators of sailboats, kayaks, standup paddle boards, rowboats, canoes and any other watercraft without a motor are not required to have a boating safety certificate to be on the water. However, it is always a good idea to take a boating course.

Please check out the NYS parks website. Remember, it is all of our Lake, and it is up to all of us to keep our Lake, Lime Lake, a safe Lake for all of us!
